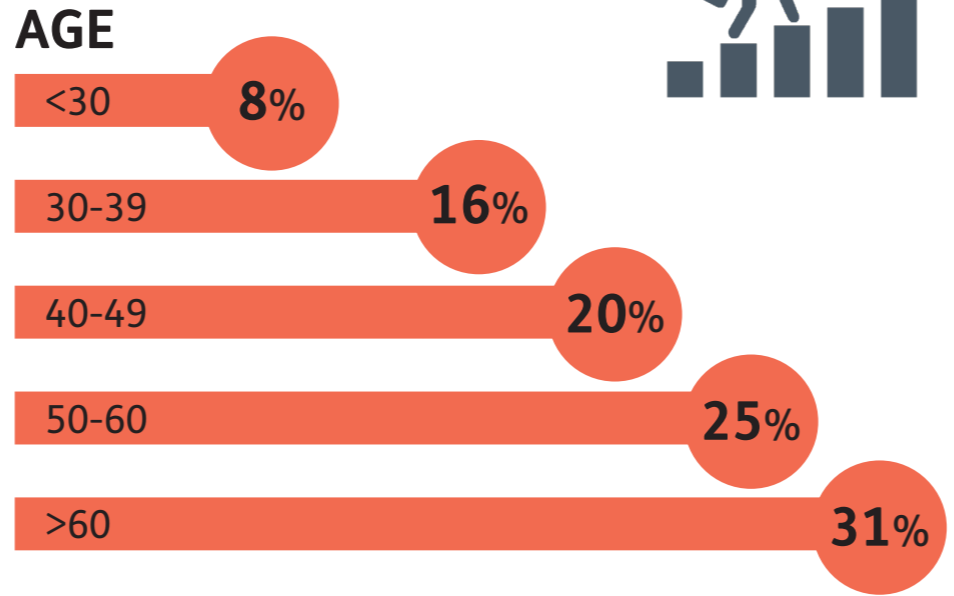
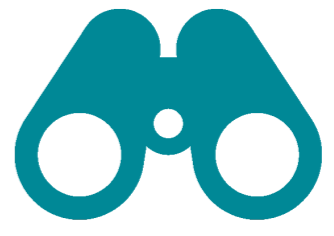

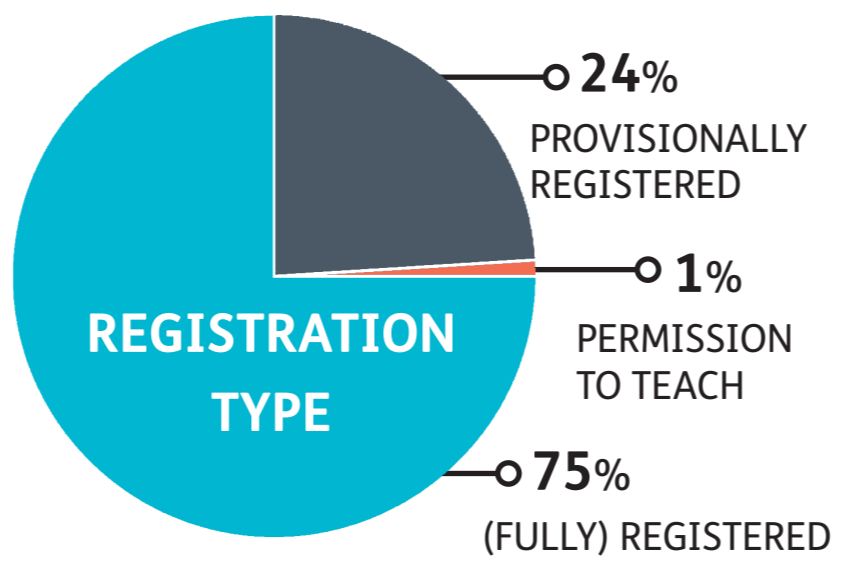


2.4 DAYS AVERAGE NO. OF DAYS EMPLOYED IN A WEEK



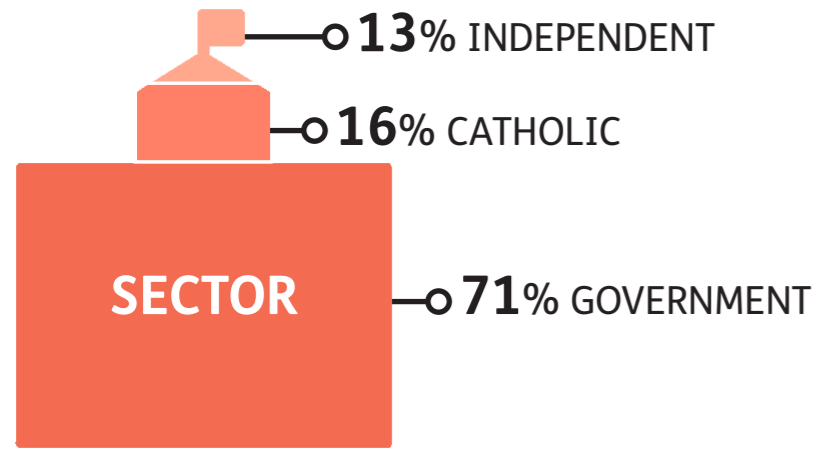

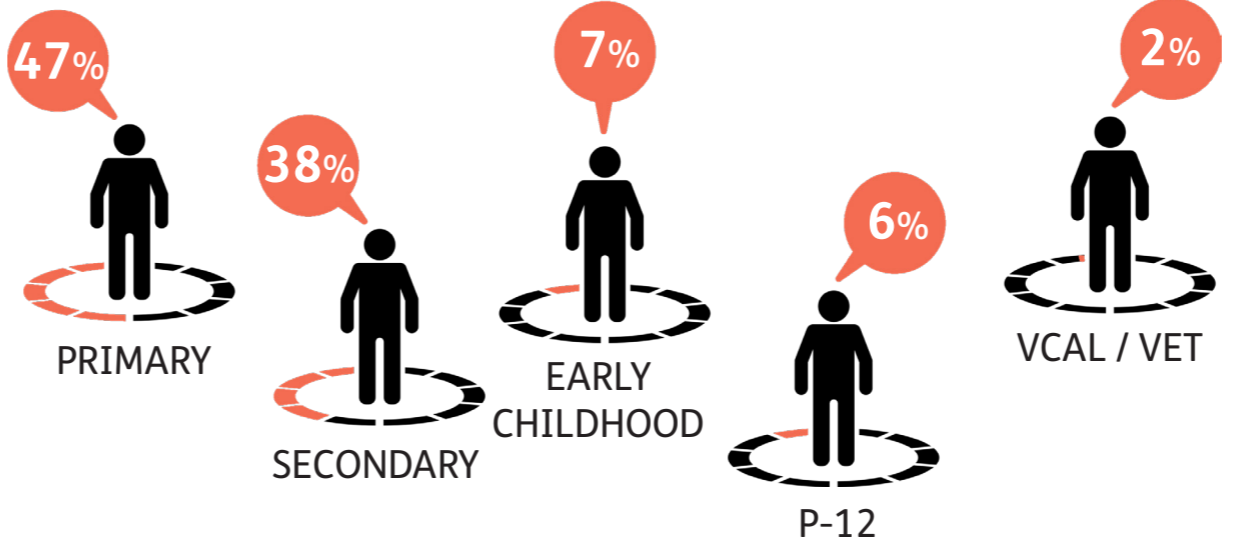
CHALLENGES MOVING TO (FULL) REGISTRATION

- 24% OBTAINING EXTENDED EMPLOYMENT TO UNDERTAKE INQUIRY
- 19% FINDING A SCHOOL / SERVICE TO SUPPORT ME
- 18% UNDERSTANDING WHAT IS REQUIRED
- 16% EVIDENCING ALL APST DESCRIPTORS
- 13% THE REQUIREMENT FOR 80 DAYS OF TEACHING
