HOW TO MOVE TO FULL REGISTRATION: #5 HOW TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT YOUR ACTION PLAN

Ok so you've figured out your inquiry question and you've visited your colleague. Now it's time for your action plan.

First, talk to your colleague about what you're trying to achieve. They'll give you some guidance in developing your plan.

What do you need to include in your plan?

- *teaching activities*
- *strategies*
- *and assessment tasks.*

How much time should you allocate to implement your plan?

- *4-6 weeks if you see your students every day*
- *longer if you don't.*

Ok now it's time to implement your plan. Here's where your mentor or experienced colleague visits you at least three times. They should work with you and provide feedback, based on the APST.

To get the most out of these three visits

- *plan together what you'll do*
- *your colleague can team-teach, or be a class helper*
- *have a conversation afterwards – based on observations and samples of learners work.*

When you present to the recommendation panel, you'll need to show them the following evidence of your action plan at work

- *what learning outcomes you set out to achieve*
- *what resources, practices and activities used to teach the content*
- *what was effective and what strategies you used to support the learning.*

Remember with every piece of evidence, show which APST descriptor you are referencing.

When you've finished, it's time for evaluation.
