## HOW TO MOVE TO FULL REGISTRATION: #6 HOW TO EVALUATE YOUR PRACTICE

*You've implemented your action plan. How did it go? It's time to evaluate your practice. And you do this two ways:*

- 1. Assess the learning that occurred*
- 2. Based on that assessment, explain how effective your practice was.*

*So how do you go about assessing the learning?*

- Sample your learners work at the beginning, middle and end of the process*
- Use a range of different learning activities*
- Use more than one method of assessment*
- Annotate their work samples*
- Identify areas for revision or reinforcement.*

*Now you evaluate the effectiveness of your practice.*

*What sort of questions should you ask?*

- Did the changes to your practice improve your learners' engagement?*
- What will you do next to continue to support their learning?*
- If you had little impact on their learning – what does that tell you about your practice?*
- What aspects will you apply to future teaching?*
- How will you continue to develop your knowledge and practice?*

*When you present to the recommendation panel, you'll need to show them the following evidence*

- Annotated work samples*
- An evaluation of the effectiveness of your practice using the evidence of learning that occurred*
- Reflections on what you've learned and how you'll apply it in future*
- What professional learning you need to further develop your practice.*

*Remember with every piece of evidence, show which APST descriptor you are referencing.*

*And that's the evidence-based process complete. Now it's time for you to present to a recommendation panel.*
