HOW TO MOVE TO FULL REGISTRATION: #7 HOW TO PRESENT TO THE RECOMMENDATION PANEL

You've completed your evidence-based process and compiled your evidence. Now it's time to present it and discuss it with a recommendation panel.

Normally this would be three teachers

- 1. your principal or relevant person if you work in an early childhood setting*
- 2. your mentor*
- 3. and another registered teacher nominated by you.*

Before you meet the panel, you should provide them copies of your evidence and a short guide to referencing the standards, which you can find on the Institute website here.

And now, the panel. And here is what you should present

- your evidence*
- a step-by-step guide to what you did*
- where you have demonstrated the APST*
- your reflections on your work*
- and how your practice has developed throughout the process.*

The panel needs to reach consensus that you've met all the descriptors of the APST and reached a competent level of professional practice at the proficient level.

They can then recommend you for full registration or a continuation of provisional registration.

When you've presented to the panel, the final step in the process is submitting your application online.
