

Accepted documents for mutual recognition

Applicants who hold current teacher registration in another Australian state or territory or in New Zealand can apply for registration with the Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT) under mutual recognition. The teacher will be granted registration in line with the registration they hold in the other jurisdiction.

To be eligible for mutual recognition, applicants must have financially current, practising registration in another Australian state or territory or in New Zealand.

The below table describes what evidence of current registration VIT will accept as part of an application for mutual recognition.

Jurisdiction	Requirements
Australian Capital Territory	Teacher Registration Card or Teacher Registration Certificate <ul style="list-style-type: none"> hardcopy of card issued upon registration / renewal certificate available via online account – TQI portal shows registration number, registration period and type (provisional / full).
New South Wales	Teacher Summary Report <ul style="list-style-type: none"> accessed by online services – eTAMS shows registration number, type (provisional / proficient / conditional), expiry, subject matter knowledge and settings in which they can teach (e.g secondary level English).
Northern Territory	Teacher Registration Certificate <ul style="list-style-type: none"> accessed via online services – MyTRBNT account shows registration number, type (provisional / full), financial expiry date and registration period.
Queensland	Certificate of Queensland Teacher Registration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> accessed via online services – MyQCT shows registration number, type (provisional / full), registration period, qualifications and conditions (if any).
South Australia	Certificate of Teacher Registration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> hard copy issued upon approval / renewal of registration cannot be generated via online services if lost, applicants are told to check the public online register for their details new certificates must be applied for via an application form presented to TRB SA in office – fee payable shows registration number, registration period and type (provisional / full).
Tasmania	Teacher Registration Certificate – Notification of Registration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> available via online services – TRB online shows registration number, type (provisional / full), financial expiry date, cycle expiry date and conditions.
Western Australia	Statement of TRBWA Teacher Registration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> accessed by online services – TRBWA teacher Login shows registration number, registration period and type (provisional / full).
New Zealand	Practicing Certificate and evidence of registration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> available via online services – Hapori Matatū using Education Sector Login (ESL) shows registration number, type (provisional / full) and expiry.
