

ORDERS UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE VICTORIAN INSTITUTE OF TEACHING ACT 2001

The Institute Orders pursuant to section 41 (d) and (e) of the *Victorian Institute of Teaching Act 2001* that:

1. The identity of the complainant, the principal, is not to be published or broadcast
2. The hearing into the serious misconduct and/or lack of fitness to teach of the teacher, a registered teacher, be closed to the public while the evidence of the following witnesses is being taken because of the intimate and personal nature of the evidence.
