

ORDERS UNDER SECTION 2.6.45 OF THE *EDUCATION AND TRAINING REFORM ACT 2006*

The Panel orders pursuant to section 2.6.4 (d) and (e) of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* that:

1. The hearing into the serious misconduct/fitness to teach/serious incompetence of the teacher, a registered teacher, be closed to the public because of the intimate, personal or financial nature of the evidence.
2. The identity of the following witnesses not be published or broadcast:
 - Principal 1
 - Student 1
 - Student 1's mother
 - Student 2
 - Teacher 1
 - The School Counsellor
 - Teacher 2
 - Teacher 3
 - Witness 1
 - Witness 2
 - Witness 3

The Panel orders pursuant to section 2.5.45(f) of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* that:

In the hearing into the serious misconduct/serious incompetence/fitness to teach of the teacher, a registered teacher, any information that might enable the teacher to be indentified prior to the making of a final determination must not be published.
